

New features in Photoshop CS

- 1.) Crop & Straighten – Two tasks in one command
- 2.) Type-on-a-Path –The Type Warp feature is functional, but designers who have craved Illustrator-style type-on-a-path are now much happier. Create a path with the Pen tool or a shape tool, click on it with the Type tool, and the type is placed along the path. Use the Path Selection or Direct Selection tool to reposition the type on the path, even flipping it across the path.
- 3.) Match Color Adjustment – One of the great challenges in Photoshop is matching colors and tonality between images. With the new Match Color adjustment, you can match the colors of another open document, or even between layers of the same image.
- 4.)Photomerge – Easy panorama creation, select some images or a folder of images and PhotoMerge attempts to put them together for you. You get to fine tune the project in the Photomerge window.
- 5.) Color Replacement Brush –Think of the Brush tool in Color blending mode with the options of the Background Eraser tool.
- 6.) Shadow/Highlight Adjustment – Fine-tune tonality in a neat new dialog box.
- 7.) Customizable Picture Package Layouts – The new layout editor enables you to quickly and easily customize your Picture Packages.
- 8.) Large document sizes and more layers – Photoshop CS supports images up to 300,000 pixels by 300,000 pixels and a maximum of 56 channels per image. That's up from 30,000 x 30,000 and 24 channels.
- 9.) Nested layer sets – Photoshop CS allows you to put layer sets within other layer sets, expanding and collapsing each set individually in the Layers palette. These layers interrelate in specific ways but nested layer sets may be a perfect way to stay organized and keep things under control.
- 10.) Customizable keyboard shortcuts– Assign virtually any key combination to virtually any command or tool in Photoshop. No more recording Actions to open the Image Size dialog box!
